


ॐ Adi Kailash, OM Parvat & Mt. Kailash Darshan Yatra 2026 By Road

Since 2002



MT. Adi kailash popularly known as Chhota kailash, is in Indian territory close to the Indian (Tibetan border). The first five days route follows the same kailash Mansarovar Yatra. It is ancient holy place in the Kumaon Himalayan range, similar to Mount Kailash in (china/Tibet). Om Parvat is a miracle of nature. On the slope of this mountain one can see OM inscribed in snow. This abode of Lord Shiva in a remote area is worth to have Darshan. The journey begins and ends at Dharchula.... The confluence of the river Kali and Dhauliganga, in district Pithoragarh, travel along a large portion of the Kailash Mansarovar route. During Adi-Kailash Yatra the route offers breathtaking landscape and panoramas of the mountain range of kumaon Himalayas with the mighty splendors of the snow capped, thick (API & NAMPA peaks) and the gushing Kali river. Thick forest full of wild flowers and number of water falls. In this very exciting region one not only travel along a large portion of the Kailash Mansarovar route but also gets to know and understand the social culture life of the people living in the Chaudans / Byans Valleys. The village Kuttikatti is named after Kunti, the mother of Pandavas. The great sage Vyasa muni lived here for a long time and wrote many books.

DAY	DELHI TO DELHI 06/Nights - 07/Days
Day 01 :	Departure from DELHI to KATHGODAM (7hrs Drive) Overnight Stay at Kathgodam
Day 02 :	Departure from KATHGODAM to PITHORAGARH (1645mt) (7hrs Drive) Overnight Stay at Pithoragarh VIA in route JAGESHWAR TEMPLE – KAINCHI DHAMASHRAM Jageshwar temples at a height of 1870 meter. The Main temple of Shiva is covered by 124 small ancient temples of different gods. According to Skandha Purana and Linga Purana the worship of lord Shiva was started from Jageshwar and 8th Shiva Jyotirlinga was originated here. It is believed that Adi Sankaracharya visited Jageshwar Dham and renovated, re established many temples before leaving for Kedarnath Dham.
Day 03 :	PITHORAGARH– GUNJI(3500mt), (7hr Drive). Overnight Stay at Gunji Cross the bridge over the roaring Dhauliganga and see the confluence of the Kali and Dhauliganga, travel along the Kali river through dense forest, There are numerous springs and waterfalls on either side of the river. On reaching Chhialekh the group enters the region of Byans Valley. Then comes Garbhiang village deserted because of geopolitical and geological reasons, here the Kali meets the Tinkar coming from Nepal.
Day 04 :	GUNJI– JOLINGKONG (ADI KAILASH) (4280mt) – GUNJI (4hr, Drive), Overnight Stay at Gunji From Gunji walk along the banks of the river Kuti to reach Nabi, Which has a temple and almost hidden spring in the beautiful mountain standing behind the village. Drive first to the left of Kuti and then to the right to reach Jolingkong. (ADI KAILASH)
Day 05 :	GUNJI– NAVIDHANG (3987mt / OM PARVAT) - DIDIHAT (7hr Drive) , Overnight Stay Didihat There are pine, bhojpatra forest in this region surrounded by innumerable wild flowers, this is the region of Musk, Deer, Monal and the highest stage of Himalayan wilderness. The OM Parvat' smiles in front of the pilgrim
Day 06 :	DIDIHAT –KATHGODAM (8hr Drive) Overnight Stay Kathgodam VIA in route Patal Bhuwaneshwar
Day 07 :	After breakfast departure to Delhi (7hr Drive)



